



## **Anti-IKBKB (Inhibitor of nuclear factor kappa-B kinase subunit beta) Phospho-Polyclonal Antibody**

### **Immunogen/Specificity:**

Polyclonal antibody produced in rabbits immunizing with a synthetic peptide corresponding to very C-terminal residues of human IKKB (Inhibitor of nuclear factor kappa-B kinase subunit beta)

### **Description:** IKKB (Inhibitor of nuclear factor kappa-B kinase subunit beta)

acts as part of the IKK complex in the conventional pathway of NF-kappa-B activation and phosphorylates inhibitors of NF-kappa-B thus leading to the dissociation of the inhibitor/NF-kappa-B complex and ultimately the degradation of the inhibitor. IKKB also phosphorylates NCOA3. Component of the I-kappa-B-kinase (IKK) core complex consists of CHUK, IKKB and IKBKG; probably four alpha/CHUK-beta/IKKB dimers are associated with four gamma/IKBKG subunits. The IKK core complex seems to associate with regulatory or adapter proteins to form a IKK-signalosome holo-complex. Part of a complex composed of NCOA2, NCOA3, CHUK/IKKA, IKKB, IKBKG and CREBBP. Part of a 70-90 kDa complex at least consisting of CHUK/IKKA, IKKB, NFKBIA, RELA, IKBKAP and MAP3K14.
